1. ORGANISATION OF COMPETITION

1.1. The Competition shall be organised in compliance with the following rules and regulation:

3. DATA OF COMPETITION

3.1. General Data.

Length of one lap: 3580 m. Driving direction: clockwise. Track surface: asphalt. Number of Competitors: up to 120

3.2. Competition Classes: Street (LaMSF) - **road tyres only, no tyre warmers allowed**,

No restriction to use any tyres for following classes, tyre warmers are allowed: Street-Street, Street-Superbike600, Street-Superbike1000, Super-Street, C600, C1000, Superstock600 (LaMSF), B600, B1000, Superbike, Supersport, SeniorTT.

3.3. Competition status:

3.3.1. Open Latvian Championship for following classes:

C600, C1000, Superstock600, B1000, Superbike.

Street - class only riders of LaMSF will be taken into account.

BMA BSBK – Club racing championship

3.4. The speed on the pit lane shall be limited to

50 km/h. The penalties for exceeding the respective speed are as follows:

- in the first instance of exceeding the speed limit by 0-20 km/h, 5 euros for every 1 km/h in excess;
- when exceeding the speed by more than 20 km/h, 20 euros for every 1 km/h;
- in the case of repeated exceeding of the pit lane speed, the Competitor may be disqualified from the Competitions.

4. Supplementary requirements for participants:

Speed limit 30km/h in paddock area

At least 1 extinguisher per 5 riders at the paddock area

Liquid proof carpet under every race bike in paddock area

5. Technical regulations

5.1. LaMSF technical requirements must be applied for the bikes in **Superstock600 and Street classes**. Street class are allowed use only road legal tyres and no tyre warmers.

Following classes will be held under BMA technical regulations:

Street-Street, Street-Superbike600, Street-Superbike1000, Super-Street, C600, C1000, B600, B1000, Superbike, Supersport, SeniorTT.
